Objectives for Toddlers

Social/Emotional Development

- adjust to coming and going to school
- learn to transfer trust from parents to teachers during the school day
- learn to play in centers
- learn classroom routines snack, circle time, recess, and lunch
- learn to transition between activities, and to and from the classroom
- learn to interact with other children

Cognitive Development

- begin to explore the senses of touch, smell, taste, and hearing
- show a natural curiosity about his/her surroundings at school and the world at large
- enjoy looking at simple books
- enjoy playing "peek a boo" and/or other interactive games
- learn to self feed

Language Development

- follow teacher's one-step directions
- communicate by using verbal or non-verbal methods
- begin songs and fingerplays
- begin to identify objects in books with appropriate words
- have exposure to sounds in language through reading, singing and rhyming

Gross Motor Development

- learn to walk without holding on to anyone or anything
- learn to use the climbing apparatus' on the playground
- participate in motor skills time and be able to follow simple directions
- learn to throw balls

Fine Motor Development

- grasp finger foods at snack and lunch
- grasp various art materials
- scribble
- use classroom manipulatives
